What Isn't Reusable?

- "It " pertains to all reusable artifacts, tools and reuse techniques.
- It isn't reusable if it doesn't compile, link, and execute as it used to.
Waldo - Java addressing version and configuration space
- It isn't reusable if you don't understand what it does.
Wadler - functional programming
- It isn't reusable if it doesn't address the user's problem.
Weiss - program families, Bassett - frames
- It isn't reusable if it can't interface to existing systems.
Williams - COM/DCOM



Judging the Technology

- "Magic Bullet" reuse technology meets *all* of the constraints in *all* system development cases.
- Magic Bullet cannot exist. There are always new problem domains, versions, configurations, notations and subsystems. A method is not a solution.
- Software Architect must minimize effect of these changes through the lifetime of the system while still providing the system's functional requirements.
